Membership Categories

Working Press / News Media – Full time employees of print and online newspapers, magazines, news services, radio stations and television stations whose primary function as employees is the reporting, writing, editing, photographing, presentation or broadcasting of news or news commentary, and full time journalism educators.

Dues: \$150 annually

Quarterly food/drink minimum: None

Communicator – Those whose primary occupation lies outside the newsroom but is in the communications industry, such as non-news employees in the professions of newspaper, magazine and web publishing and broadcasting; also those who work in public relations, advertising, freelance creative work, photography, marketing, video and film production, graphic arts and education.

Dues: \$30 per month (\$360 per year)

Quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30

Individual –

Associate – Persons whose primary occupation is unrelated to press-news media and communications. This includes such occupations as business, education, law, medicine, finance, hospitality, travel, consulting and politics.

Dues: \$40 per month (\$480 per year)

Quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30

Student – Persons enrolled full time at a college or university. Must submit copy of student ID and year of graduation.

Dues: \$100 annually

Quarterly food/drink minimum: None

**** Standard non-member club room rental fees apply.**

Retired – **Dues: \$10 per month (\$120 per year)** **Quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30**

Nonmetro – Persons who live and work outside the Douglas, Sarpy and Pottawattamie counties area.

Dues: \$18 per month (\$216 per year)

Quarterly food/drink minimum: None

Corporate – Persons employed by companies, corporations, non-profits or institutions whose organizations have arranged for group memberships. Dues may be paid individually or by the organization.

Corporate I: Minimum five in the group.

Dues: \$20 per month each member; \$240 per year. (Group total dues \$1200)

Individual quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30.

Corporate II: Six (6) to twenty-four (24) in the group.

Dues: \$15 per month each member; \$180 per year. (Group range of total dues: \$1,080 to \$4,320)

Individual quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30.

Corporate III: Twenty-five (25) to forty-nine (49) in the group.

Dues: \$12 per month each member; \$144 per year. (Group range of total dues: \$3,600 to \$7,056) **Individual quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30.**

Corporate IV: Fifty (50) or more in the group.

Dues: \$10 per month each member; \$120 per year. (Group range of total dues: \$6,000 min.)

Individual quarterly food/drink minimum: \$30.
